COMMON RECOGNITION ORDER

WHEREAS in terms of section 14(1)(5)(i) of the NCTE Act, 1993 the institutions had submitted applications to the Western Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for Teacher Education Courses

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny/perusal veracity of the facts & figures as per the applications submitted by these institutions, the documents attached therewith, the affidavits and the input received from the visiting team in the form of visiting team report including videography and also the reply submitted by the institutions against the observations made in 7(1)(j) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014, the Western Regional Committee in meeting held from 22.02.2021 to 23.02.2021 against each of the institutions has satisfied that the institution(s) fulfill the requirements mentioned in provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the concerned Teacher Education Courses. Each of the institutions has adequate infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory, etc. for running the programme and has employed approved duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.

3. NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(1)(5)(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Western Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to the following institutions for conducting Teacher Education Course with an annual intake mentioned against their names from the academic session 2021-22 under clause 7(1)(j) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014 subject to fulfilment of the conditions mentioned under clause 7(1)(j) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.

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4. The institution shall comply with various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations as amended from time to time. The institution shall fulfill the revised Norms relating to infrastructure, instructional facilities, enhanced amount of Endowment and Reserve Fund, Number and qualifications of Teaching staff, Curriculum and implementation strategies in view of the change in duration/breaks of programme(s) offered in the institution within the norms laid allowed by NCTE.

5. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 16(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.

6. The institution shall comply with the condition as laid down in the clause 8(C) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 which provided that "An institution which has been recognized by the Council shall obtain accreditation from an accrediting agency approved by Council within five year of each recognition."

7. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.

8. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating university/body, the State Government etc. as applicable and compliance of the following by the affiliating body, state government and also the concerned recognized institution:-

- (i) The affiliating bodies/State Govt. shall be required to verify the authenticity of the land & building documents with the required land & built-up area as well as appointment of requisite teaching & non-teaching staff as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 by the concerned institution before grant of affiliation to an institution.
- (ii) The affiliating body shall ensure that the institution is composite institution as per the definition of composite institution given in the NCTE Regulation, 2014. If at any stage, it is found that the institution is not a composite institution, the recognition granted will be treated as withdrawn and the sole responsibility of the same will lie of the institution. However, in the existing institutions permitted for additional intake, shall have to ensure that they are to become composite gradually preferably by the academic session 2021-2022.
- (iii) If the NOC of the affiliating body and staff approval thereof submitted by the institution or any declaration submitted by the institution is found false in future, the recognition granted will be treated as withdrawn and the institution shall be liable for penal action.

9. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

10. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations, 2014.

11. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

12. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the order, it may prefer an appeal under section 18 of NCTE Act 1993 in the "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte.org within 60 days from the date of the order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
